Our class will be meeting at **8:40** at our assigned outside musterpoint, at the tarmac by the senior bootroom in front of the staff parking lot. We will also be dismissing from our muster point at 3:05. Just a reminder that we have a staggered start so student's last name that start A-L will be attending on Tuesday, September 8th and Thursday September 10th and student's last name M-Z will attend Wednesday September 9th and Friday September 11th.



Our classroom is room 2011, it is located on the second floor (directly above music room on the main floor). Our window overlooks the atrium and library. We are beside the elevator. I have outlined a yellow line to show our entry into Willowgrove and the route to our classroom (from our outside meeting point).

On the first day, please bring school supplies so we can label, sort and store. We will spend much of the day getting to know each other, setting up class routines, and practicing our muster point. Our school schedule will still look the same except for recesses and lunch.







For those who stay for lunch, our class will have a playtime outside first on the tarmac then come in to eat lunch in the classroom. Because we would love a break from the mask wearing, we will be exploring activities that we can do individually with appropriate distancing and limited shared school equipment. 
